Dear Parents/Carers,

Following government guidance in response to a second lockdown, we request the following:

As of Monday 9th November

- **Please ensure your child has a face covering for use on site** (regardless of whether your child does/does not use public transport). This is so that your child has access to a face covering on occasions when social distancing cannot be maintained.
- When visiting a site, it is now deemed good practice for all parents/carers to wear a face covering when entering the building. If attending a meeting, face coverings can be removed once seated, and once social distancing can be maintained.
- We also suggest that students arrive with a face covering – as some entry points at our centres are quite small. Once settled in the classroom, face coverings can be removed.

We continue to operate in a COVID safe way throughout our centres, with the following:

- Sanitiser freely available to all.
- Low numbers on site, with minimal congested areas, which support social distancing.
- Regular and enhanced cleaning procedures.
